The Embassy of Austria Brasília greets kindly the Coordination of International Articulation - CINTER Federal Road Police - PRF and has the honor to inform you about the current situation, restrictions and procedures to travel to Austria.

Your entry fits into the exceptions, yes:

- Persons who are in an employment relationship with a domestic regional authority or a domestic public company and whose place of work is abroad or whose employment is carried out abroad, insofar as the activity of this company abroad is in the interest of the Republic of Austria.

The invitation letter was reviewed and confirmed. Please note the current entry and quarantine regulations: upon entry, a 10-day quarantine is required, which can be terminated after the 5th day with a PCR test.

In order to enter Austria it is currently compulsory to register prior to travelling on the following website: <https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en.html>

It is the responsibility of the traveler himself to prove with appropriate documents that he fits into one of the exceptions to these restrictions.

Currently some countries have a ban on aircraft landing or transit for flights arriving from Brazil. Therefore, we recommend checking with the airline company to see if the desired flight will work. In addition, we recommend checking with the transit country to see if you as a passenger arriving from Brazil can transit to Austria.

The current rules are valid until 31 August.
