
We would like to bring to your attention the attached request from the Brazilian Government to your Government, under our Mutual Legal Assistance Treaty in Criminal Matters.

It was requested that documents supplied by the United States, pursuant to a demand from the Brazilian Public Prosecution and the Brazilian Federal Police, could be shared with a Congressional Committee of Inquiry jointly instituted by the Senate and the Chamber of Deputies, to investigate alleged charges of corruption and illegal financing of electoral campaign, based on facts involving the Postal Service of Brazil.

Considering the high importance of the present matter for the fighting of corruption in Brazil, we would greatly appreciate if you could grant the most urgent priority to this issue.
