Thank you for requesting to testify at the upcoming hearing regarding the Section 301 Investigation of Brazil's Acts, Policies, and Practices Related to Digital Trade and Electronic Payment Services; Unfair, Preferential Tariffs; Anti-Corruption Enforcement; Intellectual Property Protection; Ethanol Market Access; and Illegal Deforestation.

If you have not submitted an email with your planned testimony, please send it as soon as possible. As a reminder, all testimonies must be given in English. Witnesses are responsible for providing their own translator if necessary.

Note: The hearings are on the record but no external cameras or video recording will be allowed in the hearing room. The hearings will not be livestreamed. A full transcript of the hearings will be posted on ustr.gov after the hearings.

USITC ID Requirements

Visitors are required to present a photo ID and sign in upon arrival to the USITC Building.

Valid government issued ID is needed to enter the USITC building: REAL ID-compliant driver's license or identification card. Foreign issued driver's license is not accepted as a form of ID.

Hearing Participants, Foreign Visitors, and Audience Members requesting access to building using a valid passport must meet the following requirements:

1. Physical Passports (not on cell phone).
2. Passport must have at least six months of validity beyond the dates of visit to building.
3. Not damaged or appears to be tampered with. No significant tears or missing pages (torn out).
4. Identification page with photo must be laminated properly with no loose corners (no loose photo).
