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1. INTRODUCTION

The Parliament of India extends a warm welcome to all delegations to the 12th BRICS Parliamentary Forum (hereinafter referred to as the BRICS-PF) to be held in New Delhi on 26-27 October 2026. The 12th BRICS PF will underscore the pivotal role of Parliaments in advancing people-centric development under the overall theme *“Fostering Parliaments for people-centric development”*.

Building on the rich legacy of the BRICS Parliamentary Forum, the 12th BRICS PF aims to engage Presiding Officers of BRICS Member and Partner Parliaments under India's Chairship for consensus-based dialogue on identified themes through High Level Sessions.

Four High Level Sessions have been planned during 12th BRICS-PF on the following themes:

- (i) **Resilience:** *The critical role of Parliament in strengthening institutional resilience for a better future*
- (ii) **Innovation:** *Harnessing Parliament for promoting innovation in digital technologies and artificial intelligence with a human face.*
- (iii) **Cooperation:** *Leveraging Parliamentary cooperation for a more representative global governance architecture.*
- (iv) **Sustainability:** *The centrality of Parliament in fostering a sustainable and inclusive future for our nations.*

The event will also host the Meeting of the Chairs of the Committees on International Affairs of the Parliaments of BRICS member and partner countries.

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3. VENUE AND ACCESS TO THE VENUE

The 12th BRICS Parliamentary Forum will be held in New Delhi.

Venue: Parliament House Estate, New Delhi-110001

Access to the Venue:

Only accredited delegation members will have access to the venue:

- Appropriate seating arrangements are being made for Presiding Officers/Leader of the Delegation and four members of the delegation from unicameral parliaments.
- In the case of bicameral parliaments, seating arrangements are being made for Presiding Officers and four delegates from each House at the venue.
- Delegates will be provided colour - coded badges. Each badge will display the delegate's photograph, name, country/organization, and will be non-transferable. Delegates are advised to always keep their badges (access card and/or pin) on display during the meetings and also while entering the venue.



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4. PARTICIPATION AND FORMAT OF THE FORUM

Each national parliament of the BRICS members and partner countries is invited to be represented by its Speaker or, in the case of bicameral parliaments, by the Speaker/ President/ Chairperson of each legislative house. In the eventuality that the Presiding Officers is unable to attend, the Deputy-Speaker/Vice-President/Vice-Chairperson or another high-level parliamentary leader may be designated as representative of the Parliament.

In the plenary sessions of the 12th BRICS Parliamentary Forum, only Speakers/Presiding Officers of the Parliaments or their designated representatives will have speaking rights in accordance with the format of the Forum. Speaking slots of 3-4 minutes will be allocated to each country during each plenary session.

Maximum five (05) delegates from BRICS and BRICS Partner countries will be accredited to participate in the Forum:

- I. In the case of countries with Unicameral Parliaments, maximum five delegates (including Presiding Officers/Leader of the Delegation) will be accredited to attend;
- II. In the case of countries with Bicameral Parliaments, accreditation will be granted for five members of the Delegation from each House including Presiding Officers of each of the House.

Working language

English will be the working language for the Sessions of the Forum. However, the host Parliament will endeavour to make interpretation arrangements in a number of other languages at the venue. Participating Delegations may bring along language interpreters for their convenience, for which the host Secretariat may be informed in advance.

Joint Statement/Outcome Document

A preliminary draft Joint Statement will be circulated to Parliaments of BRICS members in late September. The timeframe/schedule for receiving suggestions/amendments from member countries and the finalization of the document can be seen at page 19 of the General Information Note. Delegations that wish to propose amendments to the preliminary draft Joint Statement will be invited to submit their amendments. A compilation of the proposed amendments, as well as a revised draft Joint Statement will be circulated in advance of the Forum. The above document will be discussed during a virtual meeting of Delegation Secretaries to finalize the draft Joint Statement which will be held virtually in mid-October. The draft Joint Statement will be adopted during the 12th BRICS-PF.





5. ACCREDITATION

Delegate Accreditation Officer (DAO):

Each participating Parliament is requested to appoint a Delegate Accreditation Officer (DAO). A DAO is required to be nominated by the respective BRICS and BRICS Partner countries to coordinate the registration process of participating delegates. The accreditation will be available through an online portal from **25 August to 25 September 2026**.

The DAO is advised to submit the following details by email to bricspf2026@lss.sansad.in, latest by **31 August 2026**.

The registration link for delegates will be emailed by the Host Secretariat to the DAO to complete the registration and accreditation of the delegates. All delegates may be accredited by **25 September 2026**.

Delegation Contact Officer(DCO):

Each delegation is requested to appoint a Delegation Contact Officer (DCO) from the accredited delegates. The DCO is expected to be present at the 12th BRICS-PF and will be the first point of contact for various aspects of participation of a delegation in 12th BRICS-PF. The name and contact number of the DCO may be made available to the Host Parliament by the DAO of each delegation during the registration process.

Delegation Liaison Officer (DLO):

A Delegation Liaison Officer (DLO) will be assigned to each delegation by the Host Parliament. The contact details of DLO will be shared in due course of time. DLOs will facilitate arrival /departure and participation in BRICS-PF, etc. The DLOs will be responsible for handing over delegation kits and Conference badges/passes to the respective delegations.





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6. BILATERAL MEETINGS

Bilateral meeting rooms with varying seating capacities will be available to delegates upon request during the 12th BRICS-PF.

Rooms will be assigned on a “first come, first served” basis and will be allocated in thirty (30) minute blocks.

Requests for bilateral meeting rooms can be made by sending an email at bricspf2026@lss.sansad.in, with the subject ‘Bilateral Room Request’ along with date, time and other relevant details. Requests can also be made directly to the Delegation Liaison Officer (DLO).

Delegations are requested to ensure that the meeting request clearly mentions the number of delegates for allocation of suitable meeting room.



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7. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

ACCOMMODATION

The arrangements and costs for hotel accommodation and related services at hotel (food, beverages, laundry etc.) will rest with the participating delegations.

TRANSPORTATION

The Host Parliament will provide shuttle service for delegations between the airport, suggested hotels, the meeting venue and other points in the city related to the event. In addition, each participating delegation will be provided with one separate vehicle for the use of the Presiding Officers/Leader of the Delegation.





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8. MEDIA & COMMUNICATION

The proceedings of 12th BRICS-PF are open to official media only. In addition to official photo/AV pool opportunities, there may be opportunities for official media to cover open sessions.

Official Media (with each delegation) may apply for accreditation through the Delegation Accreditation Officer (DAO). It may kindly be noted that access to the meeting venue will be facilitated for one (01) photographer and one (01) videographer (maximum of two (02) media personnel) from the official media of each delegation.

Media advisory on media logistics, pool opportunities and other details will be communicated separately.

The official documents and statements will be available on the BRICS India official platforms.



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9. VISA REQUIREMENTS

The Government of India has bilateral Visa Waiver Agreements for holders Diplomatic/Official/Service Passports with 8 BRICS Member Countries (Brazil, Ethiopia, Egypt, Indonesia, Iran, Russia, South Africa and UAE) and 7 BRICS Partner Countries (Belarus, Bolivia, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Thailand, Uganda and Vietnam). The details can be seen at <https://www.mea.gov.in/bvwa-menu.htm>. All delegates may please ensure that their passports have at least six months of validity and a minimum of two blank passport pages for validation.

All other registered delegates (from countries which do not have a bilateral visa exemption agreement for holders of Diplomatic/Official/Service Passports) intending to travel using Diplomatic/Official/Service Passports will be issued Diplomatic & Official Visa with multiple entries, to attend the 12th BRICS-PF which will be made available on the basis of confirmed registration of the delegate.

For Diplomatic and Official Passports

Once the accreditation is complete, delegates can submit the printout of the confirmation along with the visa form to the concerned Indian Mission or Consulate, for affixing the appropriate Indian visa. A Note Verbale from the respective Ministry of Foreign Affairs, endorsing the visiting delegates' visa applications, may be submitted along with the visa application.

For Ordinary Passports

Delegates travelling with an ordinary passport are requested to apply for either Conference Visa or Business Visa (Regular/Paper visa) from the Indian Missions or Consulates accredited in the respective countries of residence or nearest Indian Missions or Consulates.





10. ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Delegates attending the 12th BRICS-PF should make their own travel arrangements to New Delhi. Indira Gandhi International Airport is the primary international airport serving New Delhi. The Host Parliament will provide an arrival and departure service at Indira Gandhi International Airport. All delegates are requested to fill out the details related to their arrival and departure in the online registration site by **10 October 2026** to facilitate their arrival and departure. Procedure for flight clearances for Special Aircraft

- (I) Civil Aircraft: A Note verbale along with completed proforma for clearance of special civil aircrafts required to be submitted by the respective local Missions to the Deputy Director (Air Transport), Directorate General of Civil Aviation of India for allotment of YA number for operation of the special flight. Any subsequent changes in flight schedules, may be notified to DGCA, for re-validation of YA number. The responsibility for handling of the Special aircraft, appointing a handling agency, arrangements for refueling/catering up lift etc. will have to be made by the visiting side.
- (II) Military Aircraft: Similar procedure, as mentioned above for Civil Aircraft, may be followed except that clearance of the Ministry will be required to be sent to Joint Director (Air Intelligence), Air Headquarters with a copy to Operations Room, Air Headquarters of India for allotment of AOR number for operation of Military Aircrafts.
- (III) Landing & Take-off: Irrespective of the category of aircraft (civil/military), movement of all Special Aircrafts will be from International Ceremonial Lounge, Terminal 3, Indira Gandhi International Airport.





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Immigration:

- The immigration process will be completed at the first port of entry (Delhi or Mumbai International Airport) in India, for all delegates.
- A dedicated counter will be established for the 12th BRICS PF Delegates at the International Ceremonial Lounge, Terminal 3, Delhi.

Customs Regulations

India's national laws govern the importation and exportation of prohibited or controlled items into or out of India, including medications. Delegates are allowed to bring medication, for personal use only. Drugs containing narcotics are prohibited from entering India. Those containing psychotropics are restricted and must be declared. In addition, delegates may carry a letter from their physician and/or a copy of the original prescription stating the list of medication(s) and amount used per day.

The government exempts some excisable goods purchased abroad for personal use from import duties, excise, and taxes for every adult at each arrival with the following maximum allowance: 2 Liters Alcohol; 100 Cigarettes; 25 Cigars; 125 grams Tobacco. Incoming delegates carrying more than USD 10,000 (or equivalent in other foreign currencies) in cash. Delegates may also note that the following four items are NOT to be carried in personal baggage of delegates/ officials travelling by air in India: Cigarette lighters, e-cigarettes, satellite phones and drone.



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11. USEFUL INFORMATION

CLIMATE & WEATHER

In October, daytime temperatures reach warm highs of 31°C to 33°C (88°F–93°F), while nights become cool and comfortable with lows dropping to around 19°C to 20°C (66°F–68°F). Rainfall is rare as the monsoon fully recedes, bringing clear, sunny days.

Humidity: a noticeable drop in relative humidity, as the monsoon moisture clears out.

DRESS CODE: Dress code for all meetings is formal business attire or National Dress.

TIME ZONE

Local time in New Delhi is India Standard Time (IST) which is GMT+5½ hours.

INTERNATIONAL DIAL CODES

The country code for India is +91, and the local code for New Delhi is 011. To call a local number, you can dial +91 followed by the local code and then dial the number you wish to call. To call an Indian mobile number when calling from a foreign number, you may please dial +91 followed by the mobile number you wish to contact.

CURRENCY AND BANKING

The currency of India is the Indian Rupee (INR). Currency is easily exchanged at the airport, designated Government of India-approved dealers as well as designated hotels. There will also be facilities for currency exchange at the Hotels. Major foreign credit cards are accepted in most of the establishments; hotels, restaurants, and stores.

HEALTH INFORMATION

All passengers who are travelling from Yellow Fever endemic countries, as notified by World Health Organization, are advised to take Yellow Fever vaccination 10 days before their scheduled arrival in India. 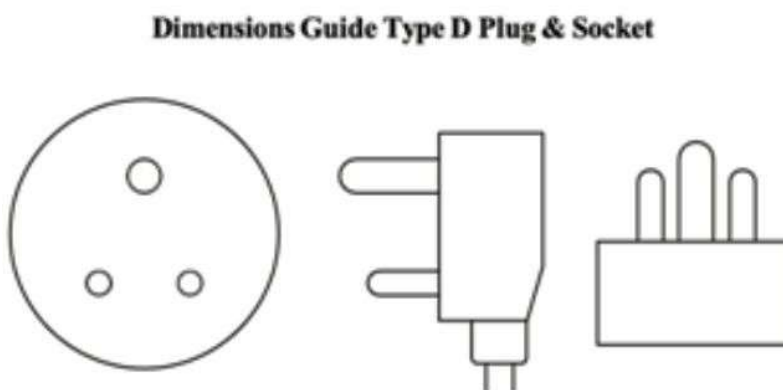
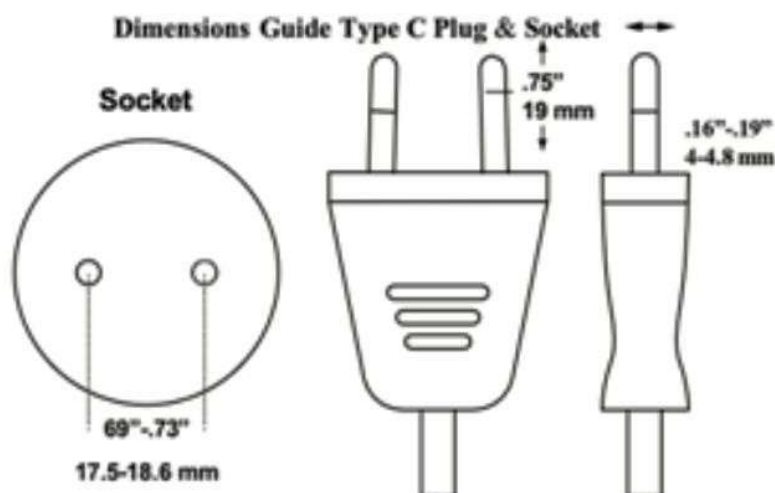
