### Invitation to the World Summit of Regions for Climate – Paris, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> October 2014

Dear Mr. Lucena Filho,

Today, climate change is a disrupting force affecting all continents. For two decades, the international community has been working towards common solutions, however, major challenges remain. Climate change, the most serious threat of our times, cannot be solved without the proactive involvement of all international stakeholders and in particular of subnational actors.

As President of *R20 Regions of Climate Action*, I launched a debate on the role to be undertaken by regions in the fight against climate change. *R20 Regions of Climate Action* is a non-governmental organization founded in 2010 by former California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger. 



## BECOME LEADERS OF CHANGE

- Join a global movement in the fight against climate from the bottom up, through innovation and green growth.
- Participate in an international event involving regional governments and local authorities from around the world.
- Contribute to the creation of a dynamic and participatory platform that gathers regional actors committed to launching a new global agreement on climate change.



## OBJECTIVES

On the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of October 2014, R20 Regions of Climate Action will host the World Summit of Regions for Climate in Paris, at the Palais d'Iena, in the Ile-de-France region.

Chaired by former Governor of California Arnold Schwarzenegger, founder of the non-governmental organization R20 Regions of Climate Action and Michèle Sabban, President, this summit of global importance will bring together regions and local governments from across five continents, as well as economic leaders, in order to formulate a new international agreement on climate change.

- Participate in a global movement that mobilizes all active sectors in the area of climate change, from the bottom up, to facilitate commitments during the 2015 COP21 event in Paris.
- Mobilize regions, cities, companies and investors around a joint declaration - the Paris Declaration.
- Engage in a series of concrete actions within the same framework as that of the Road to Paris 2015, so as to advance the "positive agenda" of COP21 (Paris 2015).
- Showcase innovative solutions and initiatives that boost green growth and create green jobs.

## R20 REGIONS OF CLIMATE ACTION



*Arnold Schwarzenegger, Founder and Michèle Sabban, President of R20 Regions of Climate Action.*

R20 is an international non-profit organization created by former California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger in 2010. Led by Michèle Sabban, its mission is to help states, provinces, regions, cities and other subnational governments to **develop low-carbon and climate resilient economic development projects**, as well as policies and best practices for mitigating climate change.

Examples of projects include:

- Assisting the city of Rio de Janeiro to install its new eco-streetlight system
- Setting up a “zero-waste” program for the province of Oran in Algeria
- Establishment of a biogas system that cuts down on energy consumption, in partnership with local engineers in Delta State, Nigeria

### FORMAT

The two-day event will include:

- Plenary sessions held to address major issues
- Areas to review the commitments of key stakeholders
- Presentations on major projects and initiatives
- Opportunities for networking
- A declaration of commitment - the Paris Declaration for Partnership on Climate

The day before the official opening, on **October 9th**, a workshop day will be led by the Collegium International, under the presidency of Michel Rocard, to give experts point of view on new governance to face climate change.

### PARTICIPANTS

Participants will discuss their approaches to climate change mitigation during the event, with the aim of extending these exchanges throughout the COP21 process.

### THE AUDIENCE

The audience will consist of a target group of 500 participants: regional presidents, government representatives, business leaders, media, associations, universities and experts.

### PARTNERS

The World Summit of Regions for Climate will be organized in partnership with networks, associations, institutions, economic and industrial actors, as well as the international media with whom you will be able to promote your own climate change initiatives.




