Rumors of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO) around the area of Echo Flight during the time of fault were disproven.

A Mobile Strike Team, which had checked all November Flight's LFs on the morning of 16 March 67, were questioned and stated 83 that no unusual activity or sightings were observed. (U)

The 801st Radar Squadron, Malmstrom AFB, gave a negative port on any radar or atmospheric interference problems related 84 to Echo Flight. (U)

Dear Mr. Salas:

I apologize for the delay in responding to your inquiry about my recollection of the events concerning UFO sighting around Echo and November Flights. As I mentioned by telephone, it was my recollection that there were no compelling explanations given about the cause of the incident in March 1967.

I don't specifically recall the foundation for the report in the history on page 38 that stated the rumors about UFO were disproven. This section of the history includes the response of the Mobile Strike Team and the radar squadron's report of no sightings or radar readings. This information was obtained from the footnoted report by the Engineering Investigation Team. I don't recall interviewing the Mobile Strike Team or anyone in the Radar Squadron. What I do recall is that there was a general unwillingness to discuss the subject by anyone I contacted.

As I mentioned, I was an enlisted airman with no command authority and the position of base historian was not given much attention or support by the command structure. The history would be reviewed by the command structure and sometimes changes would be prescribed before it was released. There were two times that I recall where sections of the history were scrutinized and changes beyond editorial were made. These were the UFO sightings history and a reported morale problem in the fighter interceptor group.

I do not know anyone that may have additional information about the incident. Good luck on your novel!

The logic of the coupler was studied by the investigating team in an effort to identify a method by which both VRSA 9 and 12 could be activated. The opinion of the team was that external generated signals caused the generation of these two channels and shutdown of the launch facilities. The possibility of this is very remote due to the fact that all 10 couplers would have to fail in the flight within a few seconds of each 79 other.

The only possible means that could be identified by the team involved a situation in which a coupler self test command occurred along with a partial reset within the coupler. This could feasible cause a VRSA 9 and 12 indication. This was also quite remote for all 10 couplers would have to have been partially reset in the same manner.

Further studies of this problem will be accomplished at the contractors facility since a full engineering investigation is not feasible at this level. (U)

In this report, the Air Force estimates probabilities of failure:

- 1. External signals caused the shutdowns
- 2. The probability that all ten couplers failed within a few seconds of each other is "very remote."
- 3. The probability that all ten couplers would automatically reset at the same time is "quite remote."

Boeing lead engineer Investigating echo flight incident



There were no significant failures, engineering data or findings that would explain how ten missiles were knocked off alert...the final report would have nothing significant in it to explain what happened to Echo Flight.

...I was contacted by our representative and told by him the incident reported as being a UFO EVENT...a few days later we were told to stop any further effort on this project. We were also told that we were not to submit a final engineering report. This was most unusual since all of our work required review by the customer and the submittal of a final Engineering Report.

The Air Force stated in the telex that this incident was of "grave concern" and there must be a an "in-depth" analysis. They later state that studies must be done at contractor's facilities. Why, then, was the lead investigating team told to stop further investigation and not write a report?









