Dear Senator Eduardo Girao,

I write to express to you my interest to learn more about recent developments in Brazil.

As Co-Chairman of the Tom Lantos Human Rights Commission and Chairman of the Global Human Rights, Global Health, and International Organizations Subcommittee, I closely follow developments in human rights. As you are aware, some of the world's leading news media have published reports of serious violations of human rights and the rule of law by officials of the government of Brazil, including the muzzling of opposition media and other violations of media freedom and freedom of expression, and the persecution of critics of the government and members and supporters of opposition political parties.

Your position and responsibilities as an elected official make you an invaluable source of insight into the situation in your country and uniquely qualified to represent the concerns of its people. I would like to extend an invitation to you to meet with me and other congressional colleagues in Washington and to attend a hearing I will chair on March 12, 2024 on human rights and democracy in Brazil. Through you, I would also like to extend this invitation to all of your colleagues in the Senate and Chamber of Deputies of Brazil listed on the enclosed attachment.

This hearing and our discussion will usefully inform congressional oversight over U.S. foreign policy as well as potential advocacy in support of the human rights of the people of Brazil. In my service as a U.S. Congressman I have had the pleasure and privilege of visiting your country, knowing and working with many Brazilians and Brazilian-Americans, and remain deeply committed to strengthening the relationship between the U.S. and Brazil.
